Kenyan Safari Adventure **February 9 - 21, 2006**

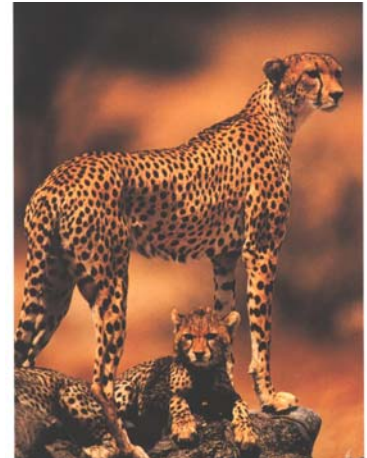
