Join Gordon and Dianne Mork, who have led tours to the Passion Play in 1984, 1990, and 2000. They were drawn to the play because of its historical significance and the authenticity of Oberammergau and its villagers.

The Morks have designed this custom tour to include the stunning beauty of the Austrian, Italian, and Bavarian Alps, complementing the extraordinary drama of the Passion Play. If you miss it in 2010, you have to wait till 2020 for another chance to see it.

In 1633, the villagers of Oberammergau pledged to perform the religious drama of Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection, once each decade, if God would spare them from the plague. According to local records, they no longer died of plague, and so the tradition began. Only villagers may perform in the play, which blends dramatizations of biblical texts with classic choral and orchestral music, as scenes from both the Old and New Testament unfold on an open air stage. The year 2010 marks the 41st time the pledge will be fulfilled in Oberammergau.
